


You will find a bar chart of each of the detected insect orders. Change between orders by tapping its name.

Burger menu







Tap "Add trap" to create a digital trap. Name your trap and tap "Save".





Select the approximate size of the glueboard according to the guide provided in the blue box below your screen. Tap "done".





The total count will appear on the upper part of the picture, as well as a count per insect order on the lower part of the picture. Select the insect order to highlight and de-highlight.





Tap on the camera icon on the lower part of the screen to take a picture, or tap on the icon next to it to access your phone's gallery for pictures taken while offline.




